

PALM DESERT CAMPUS ANNOUNCES NEW DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION

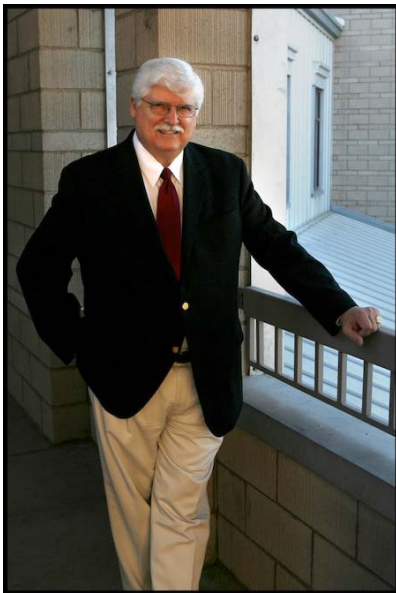

PALM DESERT, Calif. - The Palm Desert Campus of California State University, San Bernardino is pleased to announce that Carl R.V. Brown, Ph.D. will join the campus this fall as the new Director of Post Baccalaureate Education Programs.

In his new role, Brown will head the school's credentialing for teachers and its Master's of Education programs. He will replace Kimberly Hartnett-Edwards who is leaving the position to return to teaching.

Brown has worked in the field of education for over thirty years. Prior to joining the Palm Desert Campus, he has worked as a Dean at California State University, Stanislaus, and both an Associate Dean and Assistant Professor at Cal Poly State University, San Luis Obispo. He was also director of writing programs at Trinity College in Hartford, Connecticut. Much of his work has been published in journals and text books.



Brown received his Ph.D. degree from Stanford University and both his Master's and Bachelor's degrees from Arizona State University.
