Orientation event this Saturday welcomes new students to campus

PALM DESERT, CA (September 15, 2009) – Cal State San Bernardino’s Palm Desert Campus will welcome new students to its campus for fall orientation this Saturday, September 19, from 8:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.
