

Online Teaching Credentials Being Offered to Members of the Workforce

PALM DESERT, Calif. (November 21, 2008) - The Palm Desert Campus of California State University, San Bernardino is currently accepting applications for the Winter 09 term for a fast track Designated Subjects teaching credential.

Classes are offered at the Palm Desert Campus with an online option. The course work can be completed in two terms of study.

The program is geared towards people who have worked in specific occupations for at least five years. Occupations can include, but are not limited to, medical fields, nursing, banking, business, building trades, law enforcement, social work, computer technicians or many others.

Upon completion of the Designated Subjects Credential Program, graduates may apply for a California Designated Subjects teaching credential. The credential authorizes holders to teach in the State of California Regional Occupation Programs, applicable adult education programs, and career technical education programs.

To enroll, students must have at least a high school diploma. California residents over the age of 60 may be eligible for a tuition waiver.
