●With the exception of CJUS 320, the grade earned in each of the above courses must be no lower than 'C' (2.0). CJUS 320 must be passed with a grade no lower than 'C-' (1.7).

●A student may enroll in a criminal justice class three times. If a student does not successfully complete the course after three enrollment, the student must change majors if the course is required. Students may appeal to the department academic standards committee.
