Cal State San Bernardino's Palm Desert Campus announces 10th Annual Southern California Edison Golf Classic

Proceeds to support scholarships and campus development

PALM DESERT, Calif. (March 16, 2009) - On Monday April 27, 2009, the Palm Desert Campus of Cal State San Bernardino will hold its 10th Annual Golf Classic at The Classic Club in Palm Desert. The event raises money to support student scholarships and campus development programs.

Registration will begin at 11:00 a.m. with lunch and the tournament itself beginning at 12:30 pm.

The title sponsor is Southern California Edison for the sixth consecutive year. The presenting sponsors include the City of Indio and The Berger Foundation. The tournament will include a full field of thirty-six teams from throughout the Coachella Valley. We have an incredible team of over twenty volunteers that have so graciously donated their time to plan a golf tournament that really helps young men and women complete their education."
