• As prerequisites for acceptance into the B.A. in Psychology, students must complete the following as a "Pre-psychology major":

- PSYC 100 (4)
- PSYC 101 (1)
- PSYC 210 (5)

The grade earned in the above coursework must be **no lower than a "C" (2.0)**. Upon completion of the requirements, student's major will be changed automatically from "Pre-psychology" to "Psychology" status.

- PSYC 575 Internship available every quarter during junior and senior years
- Students intending to enroll in graduate school will find this undergraduate program provides an excellent base for entry into graduate training, whether in Psychology, Social Work or Education.
