## Itinerary

### DAY 1 • Depart U.S.

### DAY 2 • Arrive Zagreb, Croatia

You'll be met at the Zagreb airport and assisted to your hotel. Relax and settle in before meeting with your Trip Leader and group of 20–25 fellow travelers for a Welcome Dinner. If you began your explorations early with our optional *Ljubljana, Slovenia* pre-trip extension, you will join the main group today.

### DAY 3 • Zagreb

After breakfast, you'll set out on a city tour of Zagreb. You'll walk to the Square of Ban Jelacic (*Trg Bana Jelacica*), the city's hub. Like many medieval cities, Zagreb includes an Upper and Lower Town, and your tour takes in many of the landmarks of the medieval Upper Town (*Gornji Grad*), including Zagreb Cathedral, the bustling Dolac market, and Gric tunnel. The rest of the day is yours to explore the city. Dinner is included at a local restaurant tonight.

### DAY 4 • Zagreb • Zadar • Embark ship

After breakfast, you'll travel overland toward the Adriatic coast to meet your small ship in Zadar, one of Croatia's true hidden jewels.

Here, you'll embark the M/V *Artemis* or M/V *Arethusa*. After lunch onboard, you'll have time to settle into your cabin and get acquainted with the ship's inviting common areas.

This evening, your Captain will conduct a safety briefing and introduce you to your ship's welcoming crew. Then, enjoy a Welcome Drink with your fellow travelers, followed by your Captain's Welcome Dinner in the ship's dining room.

### DAY 5 • Explore Zadar • Croatian language lesson

After breakfast onboard, you'll ride into the center of the city for a tour of Zadar. Stroll along the marble, pedestrian-only streets of Old Town, where you'll discover

the medieval churches for which the city is famous, including St. Donatus' Church—an imposing, round, stone building dating from the ninth century—and the Cathedral of St. Anastasia, a Romanesque-style cathedral built in the 12th and 13th centuries and which holds the distinction of being the largest church in Dalmatia. Later, you are invited to learn a few key phrases in Croatian during an hour-long language lesson, an exclusive Discovery Series event.

### DAY 6 • Split

This morning after breakfast, you'll set out to discover the Imperial Palace of the Roman Emperor Diocletian in Split. This UNESCO World Heritage Site is the greatest Roman ruin in southeastern Europe. The entire old section of Split, with the palace as its centerpiece, is a virtual open-air museum with the city's contemporary life bustling through it, as you'll discover. You'll then have time for independent exploration of Split. Enjoy dinner onboard tonight. *Discovery Series*: Folklore evening is tonight

### DAY 7 • Hvar • Dubrovnik

Cruise to Hvar early this morning. Upon arrival, disembark for a tour of this verdant, peaceful island blanketed in pine—an up-and-coming hotspot for rich and famous visitors from around the world.

After lunch onboard, your ship continues on to Dubrovnik, arriving early this evening.

### DAY 8 • Dubrovnik • Home-Hosted Dinner

Croatia's crown jewel is yours to discover today. Medieval Dubrovnik sits on a rocky spur at Croatia's southernmost tip, and is renowned for its architectural beauty and stunning Adriatic views. Explore this walled city, from its pedestrian promenade to a 14th-century Franciscan monastery. Along the way, you'll learn about its storied past as an independent city-state that rivaled Venice. After time at leisure this afternoon, you'll set off toward a nearby

village, where you'll be welcomed in by a local family for an exclusive Discovery Series Home-Hosted Dinner.

### DAY 9 • Dubrovnik • Optional Konavle tour

Take time to discover more of Dubrovnik at your own pace today, enjoying lunch onboard. Or, join an optional tour to Konavle to discover what everyday life is like for locals in this valley region—from agricultural traditions to music and dance. Dinner will be onboard this evening.

### DAY 10 • Dubrovnik • Kotor, Montenegro • Our Lady of the Rocks

Early this morning, cruise to Kotor, Montenegro, a picturesque walled city nestled at the head of Europe's deepest fjord. You'll learn about the turbulent history of Kotor Bay before setting off on a tour to discover the architectural splendor of this ancient Montenegrin city, recently declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Later this afternoon, you'll depart for Perast, where you'll board small boats bound for the baroque Our Lady of the Rocks shrine on a man-made islet.

### DAY 11 • Korcula, Croatia

Many historians claim that Korcula was the birthplace of Marco Polo. Trace his footsteps, and otherwise behold this walled town, during this morning's walking tour, highlighted by visits to the town museum, cathedral, and Abbey Place. After lunch aboard your ship, you're free to explore more of Korcula's medieval streets during free time.

After returning to your ship, enjoy two exclusive Discovery Series events. First, learn about life post-communism with a candid discussion on *Croatia Today*. And after an onboard dinner, you'll be treated to an evening of traditional *klapa* music.

### DAY 12 • Sibenik

In the pre-dawn hours, your ship sails to the ancient port of Sibenik. A walking tour will reveal the city's highlights, such as

the Cathedral of St. James, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Built completely of limestone and marble in the Gothic and Renaissance styles, its construction lasted from 1431 until its completion in 1536. Later, you'll have time to make your own discoveries before returning to the ship.

### **DAY 13 • Sibenik • Optional Krka Falls tour • Captain's Farewell Dinner**

After breakfast, you are welcome to join an optional tour to Krka Falls, home to a series of cascading waterfalls that is one of Croatia's great natural wonders. Over millennia, the Krka River has carved canyons into the surrounding limestone of the Dinara Mountains, creating a spectacular landscape. Or, spend more time exploring Sibenik on your own. Tonight, gather onboard for your Captain's Farewell Dinner.

### **DAY 14 • Sibenik • Disembark ship • Zagreb**

After breakfast, say farewell to your ship's crew, disembark with your luggage, and board your motorcoach transfer to Zagreb. Lunch is on your own this afternoon.

Take advantage of free time to make your own discoveries. Perhaps you'll visit the Croatian Museum of Natural Sciences, which has a unique exhibit displaying the most extensive remains of a Neanderthal Man ever found in one place.

### **DAY 15 • Zagreb • Explore Varazdin • Farmhouse lunch**

Today, you'll venture into the Croatian countryside to Varazdin, a beautifully preserved Baroque city that's often compared to Vienna. For centuries, this was the home of several aristocratic families, who built magnificent palaces and churches that continue to grace the city today.

You'll take a walk to the city's centerpiece: its castle. Later, your small group heads to a local farmhouse, where you'll gain perspective on rural life in Croatia and the chance to savor a farm-fresh lunch.

### **DAY 16 • Return to U.S.**
